

# The Rushin' Hat

A Domestically Challenged Pattern by Allison Guy

## Materials

Yarn: Manos del Uruguay, two strands held together.

Needles: Size 13 straight needles and a darning needle



A few years ago, my amazing friend, Sue, bought this gorgeous winter coat and needed some matching winter accessories. Naturally I offered to invent something to suit her needs.

## Pattern

CO 84 sts.

Row 1: Sl 1, k1, \*sl1, k1, pssso but before dropping the slipped stitch from the left needles, knit into the back of it.

Repeat from \* until there is one stitch left, k1

Row 2: \*P2tog, do not slip stitches off the needle, purl the first stitch again, slip both stitches off needle

Repeat from \*

Repeat rows 1 and 2 until the piece measures 13.5 cm

Decrease as follows:

Row 1: K1, sl1, k1, pssso, k12, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k13, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k12, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k13, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k12, k2tog, k1

Row 2 (and every even row): Purl

Row 3: K1, sl1, k1, pssso, k10, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k11, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k10, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k11, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k10, k2tog, k1

## Pattern (continued)

Row 5: K1, sl1, k1, pssso, k8, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k9, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k8, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k9, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k8, k2tog, k1

Row 7: K1, sl1, k1, pssso, k6, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k7, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k6, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k7, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k6, k2tog, k1

Row 9: K1, sl1, k1, pssso, k4, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k5, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k4, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k5, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k4, k2tog, k1

Row 11: K1, sl1, k1, pssso, k2, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k3, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k2, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k3, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k2, k2tog, k1

Row 13: K1, sl1, k1, pssso, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k1, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k1, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k2tog, k1.

Row 15: K1, k2tog until you reach the last stitch, k1

Break the yarn leaving a tail long enough to sew up the back of the hat.

Pull yarn through remaining stitches.
